Call for Presentations

The County Engineers Association of Maryland's Spring 2019 conference will be held at the Rocky Gap Casino Resort in Cumberland, MD from May 15-17, 2019.

The conference technical program is currently under development and is expected to cover the range of public works operations and services including roadways, emerging technologies, stormwater management, ethics, water & wastewater utilities and more. The purpose of this announcement is to invite those interested in making a presentation to submit a brief proposal for consideration. Proposals are due no later than February 25, 2019. Selections will be made and presenters notified no later than March 25, 2019 (well in advance of conference registration deadline).

Guidelines:

- Please complete and return the attached Presentation Proposal form via e-mail to Conference Chair Tim Cupples at tim.cupples@montgomerycountymd.gov
- Proposals are due by February 25, 2019.
- Individuals may submit more than one proposal.
- Presentations should be 45-50 minutes in duration with 10-15 minutes planned for questions and follow- on discussion for a total of no more than 60 minutes.
- Presentations can be done by one speaker or a combination of speakers and can be organized in a panel format if so desired.
- Presentations are expected to be of high quality, technically correct, and worthy of having Professional Development Hours (PDHs) awarded to those attendees needing them for Professional Engineering licensure requirements. They are NOT an opportunity to do a sales pitch for a company's product or services.
- Presenters are encouraged to attend the entire conference and would be expected to register if they are doing so. Elected officials and other invited guests are not required to do so.

Can't make it to the spring conference, or can't have your presentation ready to go by then? Not to worry. A similar Call for Presentations will be issued for CEAM's fall conference to be held at the Princess Royale in Ocean City, Maryland in September 2019.
