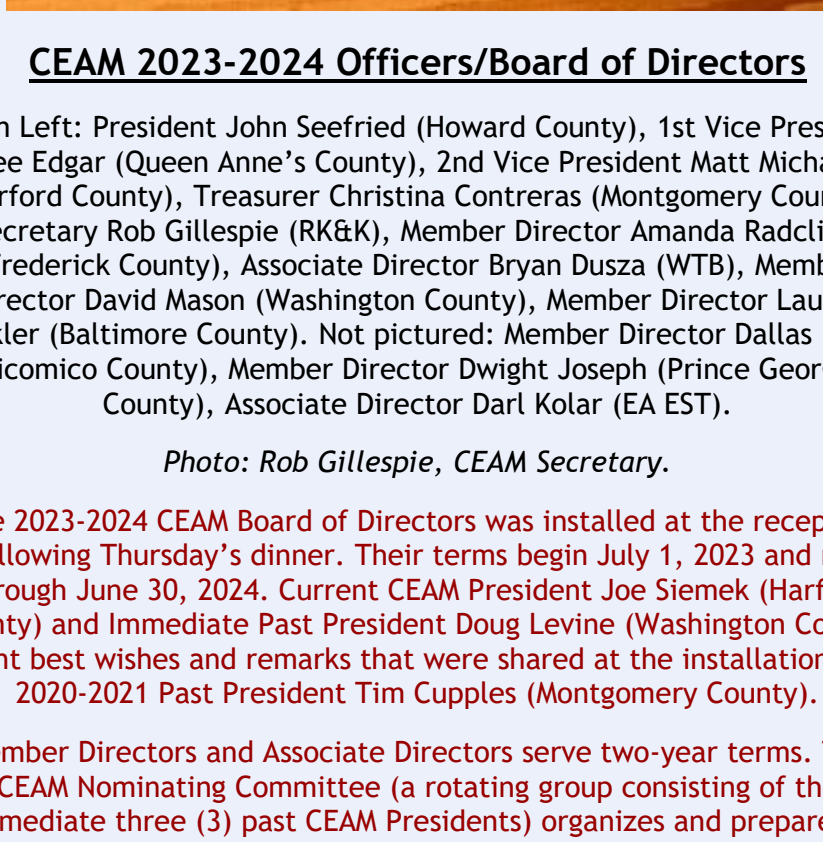
THANK YOU for attending the 2023 CEAM Spring Conference at the Rocky Gap Casino Resort in Allegany County, MD.
