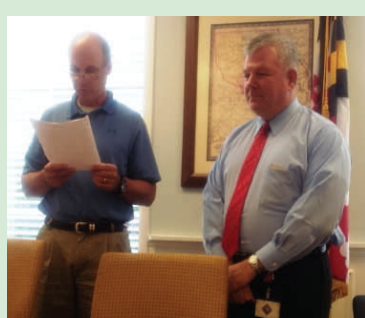
## 2012 Fall Conference—Registration

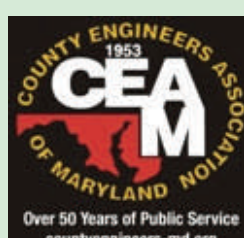
