

## Biography

Todd R. Mohn PE

Todd started his career in 1987 working in the private sector at McCrone Engineering. He worked at the Centerville and Annapolis offices as a project engineer and project manager on private and municipal site development plans. During his tenure at McCrone, Todd helped to usher in the transition from traditional drawing board design to today's standard Computer Aided Design.

He moved on to public sector employment in 1991 with Queen Anne's County. There Todd worked as a civil site engineer at the Department of Public Works serving as the lead design engineer for the 800-unit Bay City Water and Sewer Improvement Project.

In 1993, he received a promotion as a Departmental Chief in the Road and Solid Waste Division. In this capacity, he was responsible for supervision over daily operations and maintenance of the County's 550-mile road system, the County's bridge program, solid waste and recycling services and countywide fleet management. During his time in this position, he oversaw three landfill closures, replaced five timber bridges and constructed 6-miles of new County Roads.

Then in 1999, he became the Deputy Director of the Department of Public Works and ultimately was appointed as the Director in 2008. In these positions, Todd increased his responsibilities managing the entire Department consisting of 150 employees. His additional duties included providing sewer and water services to 6,000 customer accounts, maintenance and procurement of vehicles and equipment, engineering design and construction management for countywide capital projects, county building and facility maintenance and property management. Notable projects that he completed include the construction of an \$8 million Emergency Operations Center, a \$7 million County Office Building, a \$20-million Circuit Courthouse and he is continuing the multi-phased, \$50 million South Kent Island Sewer Extension project.

And finally, earlier this year, Todd was appointed as the County Administrator of Queen Anne's County. Now in addition to working directly with his five elected County Commissioners, Todd now manages the day-to-day operations of the entire Queen Anne's County government, consisting of eight departments and a \$120-million annual operations budget. This career move also facilitated a considerable reduction to his work commute time.... from a five-mile drive down to a quarter mile walk.

Todd is a registered professional engineer in our great state of Maryland. He is a graduate of both Penn State and Purdue Universities and holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Civil Engineering and a Bachelor of Science Degree in Land Surveying. Todd has been a member of the County Engineers Association Maryland since 1992 where he served two tours as our President in 2002 and 2017.
