DUTIES: Wicomico County Public Works is a multi-disciplined organization that is responsible for maintenance and operation of the following services and facilities within the County: Landfill, Recycling, River Dredging, Roads, Dams, Bridges, Storm Drains (open & closed systems), and Ferries. The Engineering Division provides technical support services to all of those facilities and conducts plan review of development submittals to ensure any proposed development does not negatively impact existing infrastructure and that new construction meets County standards and specifications.

REQUIREMENTS: Excellent written communication and public speaking skills. Considerable knowledge of the principles and practices of civil engineering, site design, and infrastructure construction. Ability to plan and design projects and prepare related estimates and specifications. Ability to interpret engineering data, read and plot field notes. Ability to give clear and concise reports on projects. Ability to develop and maintain effective working relationships with private developers, politicians, consultants, contractors, co-workers and the general public. Ability to manage and direct a diversified team of people. Competent in using AutoCad and Microsoft Office Suite. Knowledge in using software programs such as ArcGIS, HEC-RAS, Hydrocad, etc., is desired. Helpful, friendly, customer service oriented attitude. Must pass background and drug testing.
